Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) 2023-24 Results of Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) on overall institutional performance:

1. To the question whether the college provides guidance about choosing their course or subject during the admission process 91.7% students replied 'yes', 1% students replied 'Absolutely No' and 3.1% students didn't wish to say anything.
2. To the question 'Do you know the syllabus of the course for which you have taken admission in the college?' 94.8% students replied 'yes' and 5.2% student replied 'no'.
3. To the question 'How useful/effective do you think your degree will be after your graduation?' 41.7% students replied that the degree they get will be 100 % useful after graduation whereas 39.6% students replied that it will be only 75 % useful, 8.3% said it will be of 50 % use and 10.4% students didn't wish to say anything regarding the use of degree after graduation.
4. To the question about the completion of syllabus in the class every semester, 75% students replied that every semester 100 % syllabus is completed by the teachers. 18.8% students replied 80 % syllabus is completed, 6.3 students said only 70 % and No student did not wish to say anything about it.
5. To the question about 'the use of latest methods and technology by teachers while teaching in the class' 50% students said teachers 'always' use latest methods and technology while teaching, whereas 36.5% students are of the opinion that 'sometimes' teachers use the latest methods. 11.5% students said teachers 'never' use latest methods, and 2.1% students didn't wish to say anything about it.
6. To the question whether the evaluation of the Internal Assessment Tests in your college is fair and just, 81.3% students said 'yes', 5.2% students said 'no', 9.4% students said, 'to some extent it is just' and 4.2% students didn't wish to reply.
7. To the question about the Does the institution inform students about programme organized by other colleges or the University? 79.2 % students said 'always', 17.7% students said 'sometimes' 2.1% students replied 'Never' and 1% students did not wish to say anything.
8. To the question 'if the college provides information and counseling about career and placements', 79.2% students said 'always', 15.6% students said 'sometimes' 3.1% students replied 'Never' and 2.1% students did not wish to say anything.
9. To the question 'How much information do you have about library facilities', 58.3% students replied that 'reference books, journals and internet facility are available in the

library'. 32.3% students said that 'sufficient reference books are available', 8.3% student said that 'reference books in the library are not sufficient' and 1% students said 'no reference books available in the library'.

10. To the question 'what efforts does the institution provide information and guidance about health and hygiene to students?', 84.4% students said 'always', 9.4% students said 'sometimes' 4.2% students replied 'Never' and 2.1% students did not wish to say anything.
11. To the question 'if the college organizes study tours under various subject departments', 47.9% students replied 'always', 41.7% students replied 'sometimes', 10.4% student said 'never' and No students 'did not wish to say' anything.
12. To the question 'What efforts does the college take to encourage students to participate in various sports and cultural activities and competitions?' 79.2% students said, 'by appointing coaches and encouraging students to participate', 7.3% students said 'by only appointing coaches', 11.5% students said 'by only encouraging students to participate' and 2.1% students said, 'none of these'
13. To the question 'How are values inculcated among students at college level?' 64.6% students replied 'through curricular and co-curricular activities', 20.8% students replied 'through syllabus', 9.4% students said 'through curricular and extra-curricular activities' and 5.2% replied 'Do not know'
14. To the question 'What does the institution celebrate/observe days and events of national importance?', 80.2% students said 'always', 16.7% students replied 'sometimes', 2.1% student said 'never' and 1% student 'did not wish to say'
15. To the question 'if the college tries to bring about holistic / overall personality development among students through co-curricular activities', 77.1% students said 'always', 15.6% students said 'to certain extent' 3.1% student said 'Never' and 4.2% students did not wish to say.
16. The answer to question number 16 of the Student Satisfaction Survey is kept open-ended in order to collect suggestions from students regarding additional facilities they may require for their holistic personality development.

To the question 'What do you think the college should do regarding the holistic development among students?', a few students suggested the following points:

- Better canteen facility
- More study tours
- Introducing the 'National Cadet Corps' (NCC)

- Additional sports facilities
- More reference books to be made available to the students for home lending
- Organization of more cultural activities and career guidance programs.

Details of Student Satisfaction Survey

L.J.N.J. Mahila Mahavidyalaya, affiliated to Shrimati Nathibai Damodar Thakersey Women's University, caters to the needs of female students. As the focus is women empowerment and the welfare of students, all programmes and activities are aimed at encouraging academic excellence and holistic personality development. The institutional goal is Women Empowerment through Education and the teaching-learning process is student-centric and aims at enabling students to achieve competencies and skill sets that would enable them to meet the changing professional requirements successfully.

Teaching is also aimed at instilling attitudes of intellectual curiosity, a scientific mind-set and critical and analytical thinking in students. To achieve this, teachers provide guidance and mentoring to students.

The Student Satisfaction Survey was conducted with 96 students participating in it. Feedback is generally collected from second and third year students of Arts and Commerce faculties. The questionnaire was prepared at the institution, keeping in mind the key areas in the Teaching-Learning process and other important parameters required for the development of students and related to the seven criteria. Questions were asked about issues such as guidance by teachers at the time of admission regarding subject selection, methods of curriculum dissemination, teaching-learning process, library facilities, health and hygiene awareness programmes, career counselling, information regarding participation in cultural activities, use of technology in teaching-learning and other issues.

Along with fifteen multiple choice questions, an open-ended question was provided to students for their suggestions.
